2019-20 DSF Applicant Checklist Ineligible for Federal Student Aid (DACA)

To be eligible for the DSF Scholarship, students must be lawfully present in the United States. For specific details about the lawful presence requirement, please visit denverscholarship.org/lawfulpresence.

We will provide updated information if there is any executive or legislative action that requires changes to the DSF scholarship policy and requirements. For now, you should meet the DSF deadlines and requirements detailed below.

DSF Application Process

- Complete the DSF Scholarship Application by April 1 at portal.denverscholarship.org.
- After you submit your scholarship application, DSF will inform you in late May if you have met the initial requirements. Remember, you must meet all requirements to receive an award payment. Go to denverscholarship.org/scholarship-payment for more details.

DSF Financial Aid Requirements

By July 15:

- Update your College Choice, if needed, at portal.denverscholarship.org. For a list of DSF partner colleges, visit denverscholarship.org/colleges.
- Confirm that you are eligible at your selected college type (technical, community, or 4-year college/university) based on your final high school GPA. Visit denverscholarship.org/hsqpa for more information.
- Complete your financial aid requirements at your college (this may include completing an institutional financial aid application or a FAFSA) to be considered for institutional financial aid and in-state tuition under ASSET.
- Submit proof of your lawful presence. Visit denverscholarship.org/lawfulpresence for acceptable documents.

College Success Requirements

- Enroll full-time (12 or more credit hours per term). Visit denverscholarship.org/full-time for more information.
- Complete your Student Success Requirements. Visit denverscholarship.org/ssr to view your requirements.
- Meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy at your college each term.
- Your eligibility is also based on the type of college you attend. Visit denverscholarship.org/yearsofeligibility for more information.
- Receive your initial DSF scholarship award no later than December 31 of the year following your high school graduation to be eligible to apply in the future.
- Complete the DSF Scholarship Renewal Application by April 1 each year.

Communications

- After DSF confirms your financial aid and college success requirements directly with your college, DSF will inform you of your scholarship award status in early to mid-September.
