



# Application Withdrawal Form

If you submitted a 2019-20 DSF Scholarship application and wish to withdraw your application because you do not meet the minimum high school grade point average (GPA) requirement to enroll in your desired college type, complete the required steps below. ### Required Steps:

- Review this form with your parent/guardian
- Both you **AND** your parent/guardian must sign and date this form
- Submit this signed form to DSF no later than **July 15, 2019** at <https://denverscholarship.org/contactus>

### Authorization & Certification

Your signature AND the signature of your parent/guardian is required below. Without the required signatures, this form is not complete and it cannot be processed by Denver Scholarship Foundation (including its employees, agents, and representatives, "DSF").

**By submitting this form, you and your parent/guardian indicate agreement with each of the following statements:**

- I will not be considered for a scholarship award for the entire 2019-20 academic year.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to re-apply, if I am eligible, as a New Applicant during the 2020-21 application cycle.
- I understand I must meet the High School GPA Exception Request requirements in 2019-20 in order to be considered for a scholarship award at my desired college type during the 2020-21 academic year. *For complete High School GPA Exception Request requirements, visit <https://denverscholarship.org/hsgpa>.*
- I acknowledge that I must apply and meet the initial eligibility requirements for the DSF scholarship within one year of my high school graduation, and become a DSF Scholarship Recipient by December 31 of the year after my high school graduation, in order to be eligible for future DSF Scholarship awards.
- I understand that if I graduated from high school in 2018, withdrawing my 2019-20 application will make me ineligible to apply for the DSF scholarship in the future.
- **I understand that I will not be considered for a DSF appeal if I do not re-apply for 2020-21 or do not submit the required High School GPA Exception Request and college transcript by July 15, 2020.** I am responsible for understanding the minimum GPA requirements for my intended college type and the steps needed to request a GPA exception.
- I understand the scholarship policy is subject to change every year and the eligibility and deadline requirements may change.
