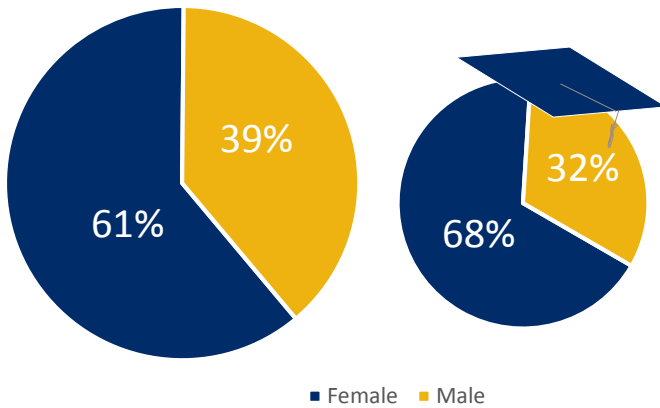

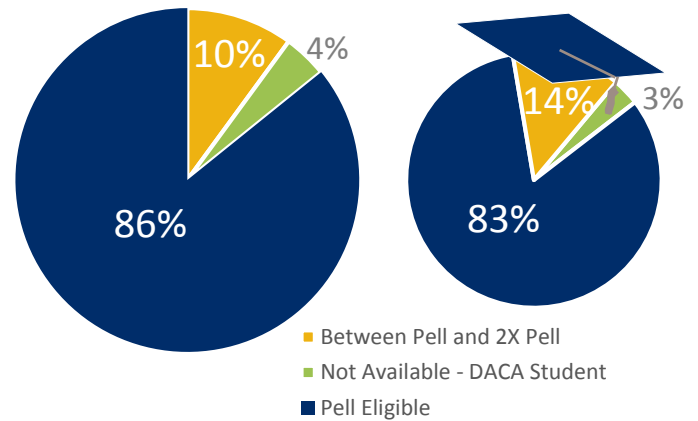

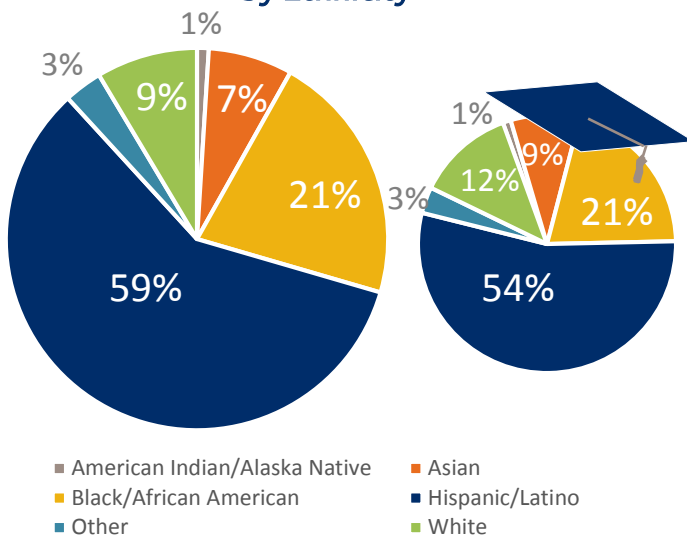
All DSF Scholars & Graduates by Gender



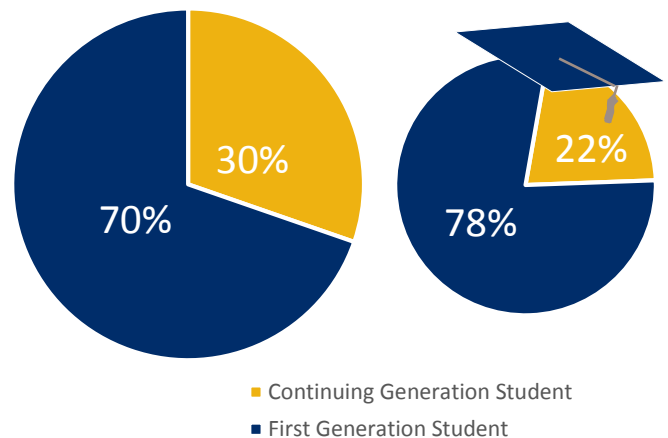
All DSF Scholars & Graduates by Pell Eligibility

All DSF Scholars & Graduates by Generation to College



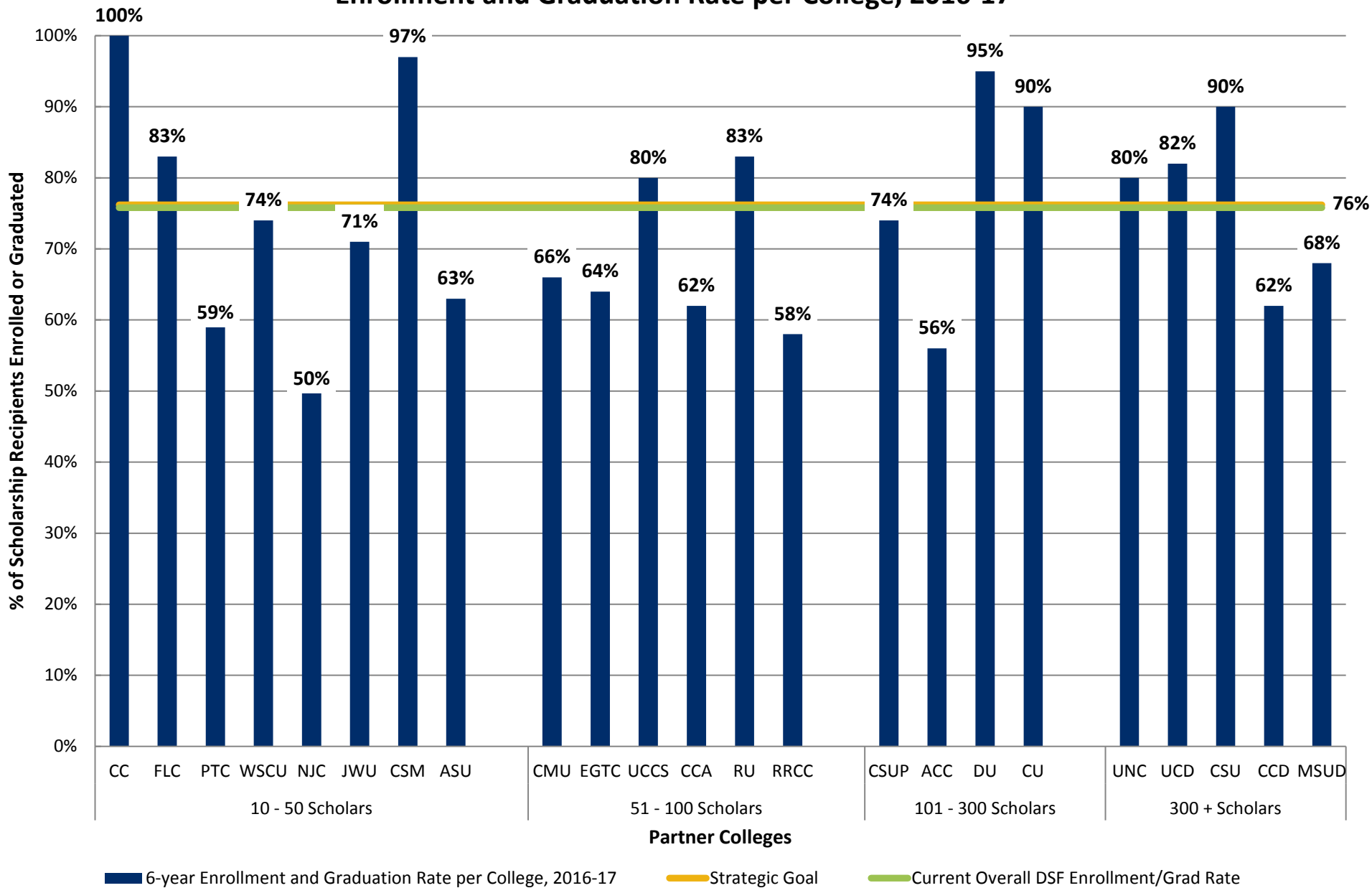
Since its founding in 2007, DSF has served 5,651 Scholars, including 1,822 graduates.

**Since 2011 DSF has served 3,617 Scholars, including 813 Graduates*

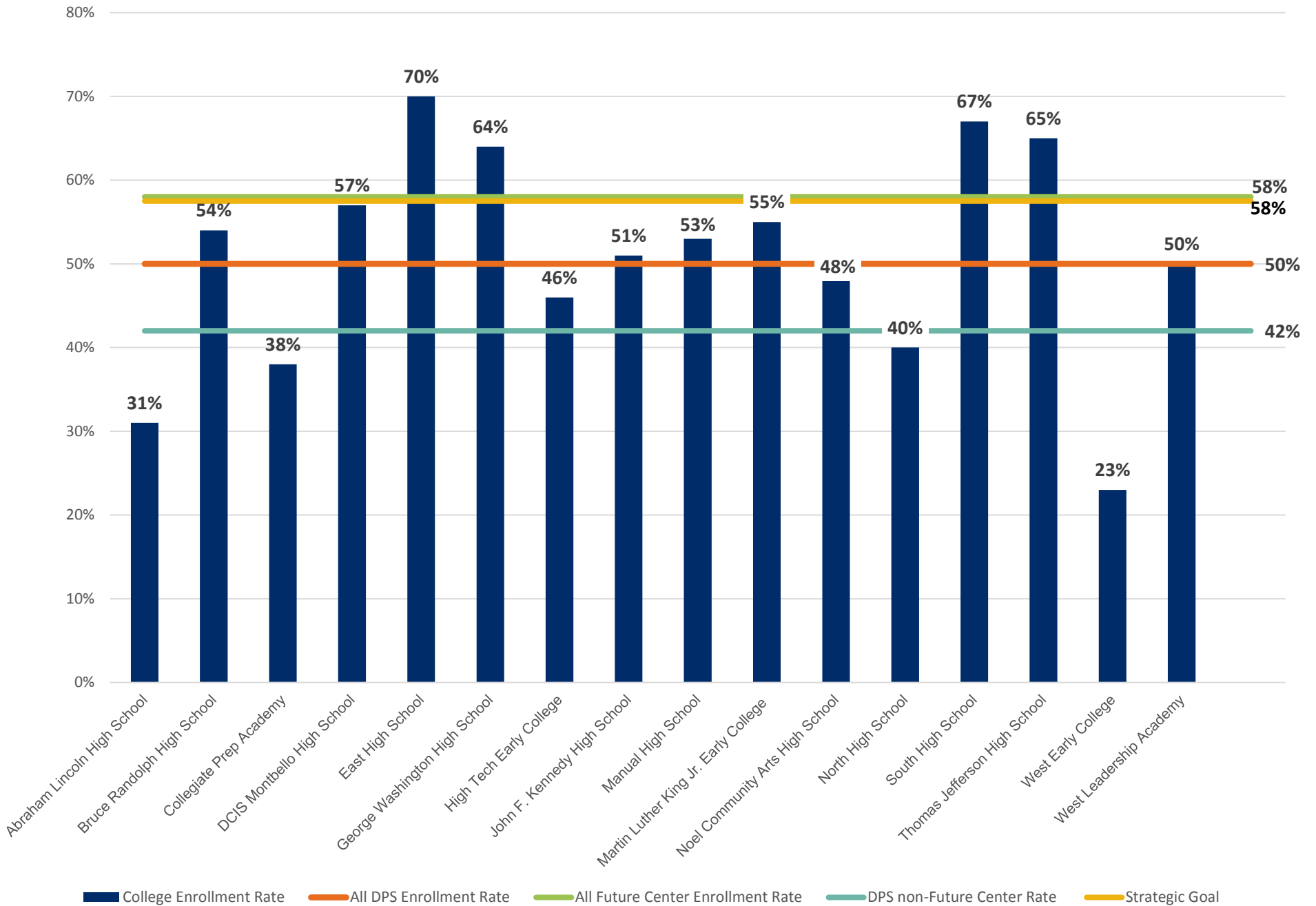
"Scholars" includes those in cohorts 2011-2016 who have received a scholarship payment from DSF.
