



# **Data Evaluation Intern**

**TITLE OF POSITION:** Data Evaluation Intern

**PURPOSE OF JOB:** This position is a non-paid internship within the program department of the Denver Scholarship Foundation. The Data Evaluation Intern will support the Assistant Director of Data and Evaluation and the Scholarship Team in delivering clean data for analysis and reporting for the purposes of assessing student success and progression through the postsecondary education process.

**ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

May include but are not limited to:

- Collect data from different sources, which can include: Denver Public Schools, DSF historical data, National Student Clearinghouse, etc.
- Clean and reformat data using Microsoft Excel to ensure proper symmetry with DSF data standards
- Organize data in different layouts in preparation for the Assistant Director of Data and Evaluation to utilize for analysis
- Critically think through the raw data to ensure quality and alignment with the project request
- Protect student data by following student privacy guidelines set forth by the Denver Scholarship Foundation

**QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED:**

- A passion for the Denver Scholarship Foundation's mission, vision, and values
- Strong interest in working with data and an understanding of how clean data drives all essential components of nonprofit management
- Exceptional attention to detail
- Strong critical thinking and analytical skills
- A positive attitude and a sense of humor
- A keen sense of curiosity
- Comfort with asking questions early on in the training process to fully grasp the task at hand

- A high level of computer proficiency including data management softwares and platforms such as Salesforce
- Reliable, responsible, and punctual

**TIME COMMITMENT:**

- 3 hours a week on a consistent schedule for the duration of the internship period
- 1 semester minimum requirement with an opportunity to continue
