Red Rocks Community College (RRCC) Student Success Requirements for 2019-2020

All New first time to college DSF Scholars must:

- Participate in First Year Experience (FYE) programming including, but not limited to, attendance at 1 or more FYE Student Success campus workshops each term, or enrolling in a 1 credit FYE course or a 3 credit FYE designated general education course within their first 2 semesters.

All New DSF Scholars must:

- Meet with the DSF Campus Contact to complete and/or review their Educational Planning Guide **before classes start** for the semester and once prior to November 1 for Fall semester or April 1 for Spring semester.

All Renewal DSF Scholars must:

- Meet with the DSF Campus Contact **within 60 days** of the start of each semester.
- Receive academic advising and meet with the DSF Campus Contact to prepare for registration for the next term by November 1 for Fall semester or April 1 for Spring semester.
