STUDENT SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR 2021-22

COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF DENVER (CCD)

DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:



ALL DSF SCHOLARS MUST:



Attend 3 meetings a semester with your DSF Campus Advisor to complete an academic plan in Navigate and to create a pathway to graduation and/or transfer.



Attend two Student Success Workshop before November 6 in Fall semester and April 10 in Spring Semester.



Students in the following programs must connect with Pathway Advisors due to prerequisite requirements for program admissions.

- Health Science Programs, Engineering, Architecture, Human Services



Attend a DSF Sponsored Event before November 6 in Fall semester and April 10 in Spring semester.



At least one during the academic year must be a corporate engagement and/or career exposure opportunity.



Attend a CCD Event before November 6 in Fall semester and April 10 in Spring semester.



Participate in tutoring if required by assigned Campus Contact.



DSF SCHOLAR ON PROBATION/WARNING STATUS MUST:



Complete an Academic Success Plan and follow through with an intervention's advisor as directed by your assigned DSF Campus Contact by November 6 in Fall semester and April 10 in Spring semester.
