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STUDENT SUCCESS REQUIREMENTS FOR 2021-22

RED ROCKS COMMUNITY COLLEGE (RRCC)

DSF Scholars must complete the following to maintain scholarship eligibility each semester:



ALL NEW FIRST TIME TO COLLEGE DSF SCHOLARS MUST:



Participate in First Year Experience (FYE) programming including, but not limited to, attendance at 1 or more FYE Student Success campus workshops, enrollment in a 1 credit FYE course, or enrollment in a 3 credit FYE designated general education course at any time within their first 2 semesters.



ALL NEW DSF SCHOLARS MUST:



Meet with the DSF Campus Contact to complete and/or review their Educational Planning Guide before classes start for the semester and once prior to November 1 for Fall semester or April 1 for Spring semester.



ALL RENEWAL DSF SCHOLARS MUST:



Meet with the DSF Campus Contact within 60 days of the start of each semester.



Receive academic advising and meet with the DSF Campus Contact to prepare for registration for the next term by November 1 for Fall semester or April 1 for Spring semester.
